



# Guidelines for Lafayette's 2021 Residential City-Wide Clean-Up Days Saturdays May 15 & October 16

**General Information:** Items need to be out to the curb on this day by **7 am!** Renville Sibley Sanitation will only have a few hours to get everything to the DUMP before it closes at noon! This clean-up is for Lafayette Residents only and should be limited to about a pickup truck full or less. Many residents put items out on Friday night as *"one man's junk is another man's treasure!"* BUT – if you are out looking for treasurers please remember social distancing guidelines.

## **Will Take:**

Extra house hold items that may include, but not limited to:

Toilets, furniture, lamps, fans, coffeemakers, etc.

Lawn mowers – *Only if oil and gas is drained!*

Carpet - *If cut to 4 to 6 foot or smaller sections, rolled and tied.*

Loose piles of small garbage, trash, plaster or construction debris must be bagged up, or in containers not weighing more than 70 pounds - use judgement... if it is too heavy for a bag, put it in a container! ***If you have many loose items you may utilize your Garbage and Recycling carts to help the workers load the trucks. Please remember social distancing guidelines if you are around the haulers – they are essential employees!***

Humidifiers (Not Dehumidifiers)

Water softener brine tanks

Mattresses and Box springs

## **Will NOT Take!**

No TIRES

No appliances! ***The City of Lafayette with Tri-County will do a collection for appliances and electronics on June 26, there is another insert with all the 2021 Tri-County collection dates.***

No Oils

No Chemicals

No Microwaves, TV, Air Conditioners, dehumidifiers - these are all considered appliances

No Concrete, Bricks, etc.

**City-wide Clean-up Day** is part of our garbage service. **If there is an item that they are unable to take due to the size, weight or type of item, it will be left.** If you will be have a huge amount of construction waste, and/or more than a pickup truck full, you may want to look at ordering a roll off cart for your project.

Coordinated for our residents with Tri-County Solid Waste

**Saturday, June 26, 2021**

**Drop off time: 8 AM to Noon**

**First**, stop at the clerk's table in the side shop next to the City office to pay for your items, Cash or your Check payable to **Nicollet County ONLY!**

**Then** you will get a receipt and will be directed to get in line to unload directly to the recycling truck.

**Appliances** – MUST BE EMPTY - clothes washers and dryers, dishwashers, hot water heaters, furnaces, garbage disposals, trash compactors, microwave ovens, ranges & stoves, dehumidifiers, freezers, refrigerators, and air conditioners.

**Electronics** – Televisions, computer equipment, stereo, VCR/DVD/CD players, copier, cell phone, boom box, and fax machines.

## **Charges for drop off items:**

Appliances: **\$10**; very large or commercial appliances will be charged higher

Keyboards, mouse, cell phones: **\$1 each**

Monitor, printers, stereos, VCR, TVs 19" or less: **\$5 each**

Complete Computer Set: Tower, monitor, mouse and key board: **\$10 per set**

Computer Hard Drives: **\$5 each**

TVs and other electronics larger than 19": **\$10 each**

**Practice social distancing; hand sanitizer will be available.**

**\*\*Just added...A Shredding Event to be held at the County Garage parking lot this same day and time. Limit 5 boxes.\*\***

## 2021 Household Hazardous Waste (HHW) disposal information

The Blue Earth County household hazardous waste facility will be open starting Tuesday, April 6<sup>th</sup>, 2021.

The facility is located at 651 Summit Avenue in Mankato.

The facility is open to residents in Le Sueur and Nicollet Counties and disposal of household hazardous waste materials is free for Residents only.

Examples of acceptable materials are: paints (oil & latex), stains, garden chemicals, cleaners, degreasers, adhesives, antifreezes, car waxes, used oil and gas, solvents, roofing tars, cooking oil, batteries, light bulbs, etc.. Please go to the Blue Earth County household hazardous waste web page for a complete list of acceptable materials.

Small Businesses will need to make special arrangements through Tri County Solid Waste at 507-381-9196 to set up an appointment and costs will vary depending on material type and quantity.

The 2021 Hours of operation are as follows: No appointments will be required for regular residential drop off.

First day open is - April 6 (Tuesday)

Tuesdays, Noon to 6 p.m.

Wednesdays, Noon to **4 p.m.**

Thursdays, Noon to **4 p.m.**

**Second** Saturday of the month: 8 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

**The Product Re-Use Center** will be open Tuesday afternoons (Noon to 6 p.m.) **BY APPOINTMENT ONLY** – Please call – 507-304-4251 to make appointments.

\*\*\*\* This could change depending on any latest COVID-19 developments /requirements.

The regular season will close on October 28<sup>th</sup>

The Blue Earth County HHW facility will completely shut down in November and will be open for appointments starting in December – February. All of this is subject to change in any developments regarding COVID 19.
