

PLEASE Use proper cart placement procedures. Automated collection is in use to help keep your cost down. Because the cart grabber needs room to grab your cart the carts should be placed 3-4 feet apart and 3-4 feet away from any obstacles such as cars, poles & mailboxes. The lid opening should face the street and the handle towards the house, this helps facilitate proper emptying of contents and prevents breakage of lids.

- **RECYCLING NOTICE!** NO PLASTIC BAGS! Due to changes in the recycling industry "Plastic bags or plastic wraps" of any type are no longer allowed in your recycling cart. All items should be placed loose in your cart not bagged up! No STYRO FOAM of any type is accepted. Please recycle only clean empty food and beverage containers and bottles with a neck made from Glass or plastic, tin cans, plastics 1-5, aluminum cans, paper and cardboard . Please flatten or break down large boxes. Large quantities of cardboard should be flattened and bundled no bigger than 1x3 feet. DO NOT stuff large boxes into cart as they may not come out when cart is inverted. Jars of grease, full containers of food, flower pots full of dirt ,shoes, dirty diapers, windshield wiper blades, scrap metal plastic toys, greasy pizza boxes etc.... should NOT be placed in your recycling cart. If these items are in your cart it will be left behind. They should be disposed in the trash. Following these guidelines help keep your recycling cost down and maintain a successful recycling program for your community
- **TRASH VOLUME!** As required by state and county regulations, disposal rates are based on "weight and volume . Excess trash bags outside or above the top of your can with the **lid closed** MUST display a bag tag. Bag tags may be purchased at City Hall or Genex. If you need to upgrade your can size please call the city clerks office to do so. Help keep your neighborhood clean! PLEASE do not stack loose trash on the top of your can as it ends up on the ground when the carts are raised to be emptied. Extra bags of trash should be placed on ground a proper distance from cart. Your trash is processed at a "Waste to Energy " facility. Construction material, rocks, dirt, concrete , yard waste should not be placed in your can. Cart weight should not exceed 30 lbs for a 30 gal, 60 lbs for a 60gal and 90 lbs for a 90 gal cart.
